When the Light Goes Out draws together the four-year Cheshire East Reflects programme of activities and events created by Cheshire East Council to commemorate the First World War.

Opportunity 4: Community Company Performers

Lead artists **Yet Another Carnival** are looking for local groups from schools, societies, clubs and members of the public to work with them to create a promenade performance which tells the Cheshire East story of the Great War.

Through drama workshops led by **Yet Another Carnival's** team of professional theatre makers, groups will create performance and movement pieces as well as props, which will form part of a promenade performance at Tatton Park on Sunday 11 November.

During the workshop sessions, groups will learn about the history of Cheshire East's First World War as well as be given the opportunity to respond creatively to the historical material and contribute ideas to the parade, artefacts and props being made.

Workshop sessions will take place September – November 2018 at a mutually agreed venue and time, ideally where & when your group regularly meet.
