Create Your Own Telegram



Telegrams

This activity is suitable for: **Ages 7+**

During World War One, important messages were sent from the battle field to home by telegram. Telegrams cost 6d (about 2p) for every nine words, and a penny for each word after that, so messages were short and unimportant words were left out. People would use clever codes to enable them to write more complicated messages without spending too much and every sentence ended with the word "stop".

Imagine you are a soldier or a medic away from home in World War One. You are trying to get a message to a friend or family member who is back at home. Can you write a telegram using less than 15 words? You can make up your own codes to shorten the message, just remember to give us the definition so that we can translate your telegram.
